



NESLi2 SMP

JISC Collections has extended the NESLi2 initiative to include online journals from small and medium sized publishers.

NESLi2 is one of the most successful strands of JISC Collections activity generating average annual savings of over £3 million for the education community. Becoming a NESLi2 publisher is reliant on demand from the education community, and with only a limited number of negotiations funded annually, smaller publishers can be overlooked.

In response to institutional demand, NESLi2 SMP seeks to offer a broader range of journals from more publishers and facilitate access for staff, students and researchers to a broader range of online journals.

JISC Collections is pleased to announce 13 new agreements through NESLi2 SMP for 2008. The journals cover a diverse range of subject areas, including the arts, engineering, health, humanities, physical sciences, social sciences and technology.

Publishers wishing to participate in NESLi2 SMP need to meet the following criteria:

- Use of the NESLi2 Model Licence
- JISC Banded pricing which demonstrates cost savings for institutions
- Provision of COUNTER compliant usage statistics
- Implementation of UK Access Management Federation compliant technologies such as Shibboleth.



All of the publisher offers have been marked by a panel from the academic community against the criteria above, and to decide the changes that should be made so that they meet the needs of the academic community.

The aim is to foster transparency with the publishers from the outset, avoiding costly negotiations, reducing legal costs and speeding up the whole process. In return for meeting the NESLi2 SMP criteria, JISC Collections offers these publishers greater visibility for their journals and an efficient route to market.

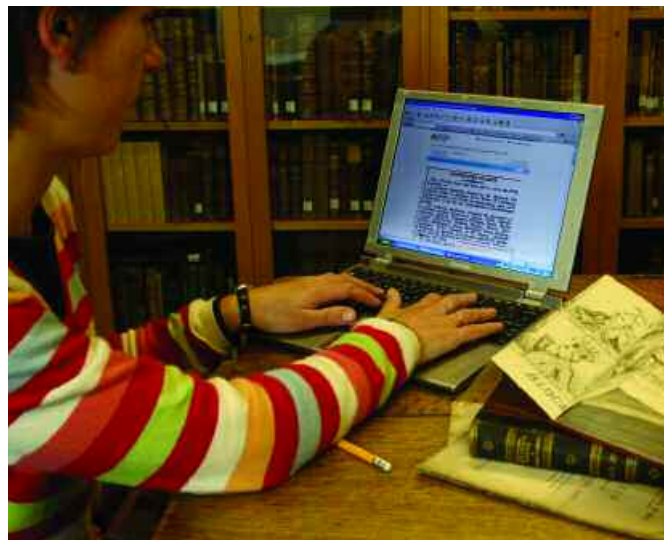

American Accounting Association

The American Accounting Association promotes worldwide excellence in accounting education, research and practice. The AAA electronic publications platform offers easy access to AAA association-wide and section journals. Their journals cover a variety of subjects including auditing, accounting education, information systems, international accounting, management accounting and taxation.

Thirteen electronic journals are included in the offer with the option for institutions to upgrade their subscription to include print copies of the AAA journals. Their latest Open Access journal *Current Issues in Auditing*, launched in 2007 is included in the package. During the subscription period users will also have access to a series of backfiles and key titles including the *Accounting Review*, *Issues in Accounting Education* and *Accounting Horizons*.

Berg is an international, independent publisher who has built their reputation through publishing in anthropology, archaeology, art, cultural studies, design, fashion, food, photography, religious studies, textiles, visual art and culture and zoology.

Twelve online peer-reviewed journals are included in the offer, which include the respective archives. In addition, for those institutions, which do not wish to subscribe to the full collection, Berg has created a flexible package – ‘Pick Five’ which allows institutions to select any five Berg journals, including archives with the option to upgrade their subscription to include print copies.

Additional print subscription options are also available. Key titles in the NESLi2 SMP offer include *Fashion Theory*, *Textile: the Journal of Cloth and Culture* and *Anthrozoös: a Multidisciplinary Journal of the Interactions of People and Animals*.

Brill, founded in 1683, publishes in the fields of biology, the humanities, human rights, international law, materials science, physics and social sciences with a strong international focus. 103 peer-reviewed journal titles are included in the offer, which cover all of their major subject areas.

Subscription fees for are based on an institution’s JISC Band and whether they have any current Brill journal holdings. Key titles in the NESLi2 SMP offer include the *European Journal of Migration and Law, Society and Animals* and the *Journal of Empirical Theology*.

Duke University Press specialise in the humanities and social sciences. 29 humanities and social sciences journal titles are included in the offer. Subscription fees for the offer vary according to an institution's JISC Band and there is a specially negotiated price for FE Colleges. Additional discounts are available for renewal orders for existing subscribers and for new orders.

Duke University Press are in the process of retro-digitising their journal content and access to an additional 657 issues from at least 8 titles will be included free in the 2008 NESLi2 SMP offer. Institutions also have the option of adding or continuing print subscriptions for any of the journals included in the offer at heavily discounted rates.

Key titles in the NESLi2 SMP offer include the *Journal of Health Politics Policy and Law*, *Theater* and *Camera Obscura*.

Subscription fees vary according to an institution's JISC Band. An additional discount will be made available to all institutions that participate in the offer once more than fifteen members join.

Subscribing institutions gain access to issues published during the term of the contract plus all electronically available back issues. Full text is provided for all years back to 1998. Key titles in the NESLi2 SMP offer include *Cellular Oncology*, *Biorheology* and *Disease Markers*.

Multi-Science Publishing is one of the few remaining privately owned STM publishers and continues its aim to facilitate the flow of information among scholars at the most affordable price possible. Multi-Science's publishing programme has a bias towards applied science, with an emphasis on topics of growing research interest – energy, renewables, environment and engineering.

Subscription fees for their complete list of 13 titles in the offer vary according to an institution's JISC Band. In addition, institutions which do not want to subscribe to the complete list can take advantage of the 'Self Select Option', whereby institutions can pick the titles they prefer. For subscribing institutions that take the 'Complete Package', one print copy of each title (ie all issues of all titles) will be provided, free of charge and print copies of selected titles can be ordered for an additional cost.

Key titles in the NESLi2 SMP offer include *Studies in Nonlinear Dynamics and Econometrics*, *Economic Analysis & Policy* and *Macroeconomics*.

RSM Press is the publishing arm of the Royal Society of Medicine, which publish a diverse collection of peer-reviewed medical journals with titles covering a wide range of topics from tropical medicine to telemedicine and medical screening.

Subscription fees for the 14 titles in the offer are set according to an institution's JISC Band and include access to backfiles dating back to 2002. Journal titles are available for separate purchase at full standard or online-only price. Key titles in the NESLi2 SMP offer include the *Journal of Medical Screening*, *Annals of Clinical Biochemistry* and the *International Journal of STD & AIDS*.
